This research used a qualitative approach to analyze this song lyric. The data was analyzed by identifying, classifying, and interpreting the moral values. The findings of research found that three main moral values in the song: self-belief (57,14%), positivity (21,42%), and optimism (21,42%). The dominant moral value identified was self-belief, followed by positivity and optimism. These moral values can make students inspiring, provide them positive energy, and enable them to carry out worthwhile activities into education and personal development

It found that religiosity, love, affection, loyalty, sincerity, thankfulness, steadfastness, humbleness, peace loving, brotherhood, respecting others, and optimism. The parallels from earlier study are the same as the focus. The distinction is regarding the object of research.

The researchers aim to study moral value analysis titled "Having Good Moral Values though "Never Say Never" song by Justin Bieber.

Data 3: "Gonna give everything I have It's my destiny"

This sentence explains about One's self-confidence in his ability to face challenges and achieve goals.

Data 4: "Whenever you knock me down, I will not stay on the ground"

The song instills the message that keeping an optimistic attitude will help you overcome obstacles. It encourages listeners to think about the potential rather than the hurdles they may face. These phrases emphasize the importance of sticking together and providing unflinching support in times of difficulty.

Data 3: "And never say never"

This statement teaches principles that are relevant to people of all ages. It reminds us that with persistence, confidence, and the help of others, we can conquer any obstacle and achieve our goals. Moral values are essential components of a person's personality. They are personality traits that guide people in making judgments and making assessments based on their own sense of what is good and wrong, based on collective and individual experiences.

Morals in line with societal laws, or relating the law or conventions of habits that limit behavior, are referred to as morals. This study sought to identify three moral values. They


